

How to Find Articles in Scholarly & Refereed Business Journals

What is an Academic Scholarly Journal?

 A scholarly journal publishes articles that report current research and development in a particular subject field.

What is a Refereed/Peer Reviewed Journal?

- A refereed journal has the same characteristics as a scholarly journal except that manuscripts are more carefully reviewed before publication.
- The term refereed is used to indicate that manuscripts submitted to a journal are examined both by the editor and one or more specialists in the field before approval is given to publish. More information here.
- Refereed is used interchangeably with peer-reviewed in Ulrichsweb Global Serials Directory.
- Trade publications and newsletters can also be refereed.

Bottom Line

- A scholarly journal article may or may not be refereed/peer-reviewed.
- Trade journals and newsletters can also be refereed/peer-reviewed.

Ulrichsweb Global Serials Directory lists the following under the subject Business & Economics

- 7,529 business and economics magazines, trade journals, academic journals, and newsletters published in the United States in English.
- 1,712 academic/scholarly business and economics journals published in the United States.
- 1,232 academic/scholarly and refereed business and economics journals published in the United States in English.

ABI/Inform Global

full-text pdf articles ability to limit to peer-reviewed/refereed

ABI covers over 5,745 journals, nearly 80% of which are in full-text. It includes business and economic conditions, management techniques, theory, and practice of business, advertising, marketing, economics, human resources, finance, taxation, computers, and more.

Covers 1923 to the present.

Business Source Complete

full-text pdf articles ability to limit to peer-reviewed/refereed

EBSCO's major business database contains the full text of the most important business journals, including *Harvard Business Review*. There are over 1,000 peer-reviewed journals, 1,700 trade journals and magazines, company reports, case studies, and much more. The full description is here.

Business, Economics and Theory (ProQuest)
